Heard on I.A.No.17570/2017 which is an application filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the respondents to file the Fire NOC, AERB approval, Biomedical waste certificate which may have been obtained from the concerned authorities in respect of M.Y.Hospital, Indore.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner referring to Annx.P/5 which is said to be NABH and Fire Safety Guidelines has submitted that in terms thereof it is mandatory for all the hospitals to obtain NOC from the concerned Fire Department before occupation of building. She further submits that necessary certificates are also required in terms of Annx.P/6 which is National Building Code of India.

Learned counsel for State prays for and is granted 2 weeks time to produce the aforesaid certificates or to file the reply of the I.A. explaining the position.
